## The process for consideration is:

- 1. Student, Family, and School(s) submit all required materials, as listed above.
- 2. My College Journey reviews the application, and contacts the student to set up an informal interview. (Although meetings with parent(s) are welcomed and available, this student meeting is one-on-one without other family members.)
- 3. A decision is made regarding a provisional enrollment offer, and the student and family are informed of our decision. We know you are waiting on a decision, and our goal is to give you a response within ten business days of your interview.

	Submission of Psycho-Educational Testing: All tests must be administered within four years of applying and include:
	Cognitive Testing: A series of standardized tests used to evaluate the cognitive and intellectual abilities of the student. Complete scores including sub-tests are required to provide a comprehensive understanding of the applicant.
	<u>Please submit one of the following</u> : • WAIS: Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale • WISC: Wechsle Intelligence Scale for Children • WJ Cog: Woodcock Johnson Cognitive Scale
	Reading Achievement Testing provides a three-dimensional picture of the applicant's reading abilities, measuring vocabulary development, reading, comprehension, and reading rate.  Please submit one of the following: • WIAT: Wechsler Individual Achievement Test • WJ  Achievement: Woodcock Johnson Achievement Test • Nelson Denny Reading Test • GORT: Gra  Oral Reading Test
